


Veterinary Preceptorship Program



The AO VET NA preceptorship program provides the opportunity for surgical residents of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons (ACVS) to visit a surgical center and receive further training in AO techniques. The program gives surgeons additional experience and familiarizes them with indications, planning, techniques and pitfalls of osteosynthesis as judged by AO experts. This applies to procedures such as fractures, multiple trauma management, osteotomies, joint replacement, arthrodeses and more.



Program Details

Duration: Minimum two weeks to maximum of four weeks.

Budget: Stipend for housing and travel costs: \$1750 for the first 2 weeks, \$500 each additional week (max \$2750).

Prerequisites & Eligibility

Applicants must be North American surgery residents interested in veterinary trauma and veterinary orthopedics, as well as:

- Currently engaged in an ACVS-registered residency training program in North America
- AO VET member in good standing
- Must have participated in an AO Principles of Fracture Management Course
- OR participated in an Advanced Fracture Management Course
- Must have a strong interest in improving knowledge in the treatment of veterinary trauma and orthopedics, particularly AO techniques

Application Process

Applicants must submit the following to preceptorship@aona.org:

- Completed application form
- Curriculum vitae
- Proof of enrollment in an ACVS residency program
- Copy of AO Basic or Advanced Course certificate
- Headshot in JPEG format (minimum 600 x 600 pixels, maximum 1200 x 1200 pixels)
- Letter of acceptance from AO VET North America faculty member (preceptor) at the host clinic.

Applications will be reviewed and approved by the AO VET North America Preceptorship Committee.
